TERMS & CONDITIONS



Promotion Name: Botany Town Centre School Rewards

Promoter: Botany Town Centre, AMP Capital Shopping Centres Ltd.

Participating Retailers: All Retailers at Botany Town Centre except Lotto

Participating Schools: Baverstock Oaks, Botany Downs, East Tamaki, Elm Park, Mission Heights, Pakuranga Heights, Point View, Riverhills, Shelly Park, Willowbank.

PROMOTIONAL PERIOD

Promotion commences at 9:00am on Monday 5th August 2019.

Entries close at 9:00pm on Sunday 18th August 2019.

ENTRY DETAILS

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these conditions of entry. Entry into the promotion is deemed acceptance of these conditions of entry.
2. Customers may enter by making a purchase at any retailer at Botany Town Centre except Lotto during the promotion period and donate their receipts to the participating schools.
3. Customers can submit receipts at Customer Services in centre and allocate the dollars spent to the school of their choice. Customers will earn one (1) token per fifty dollars (\$50) spent and a participation percentage will be established at the end of the campaign based on the schools role size.
4. Receipts must be from a participating retailer at Botany Town Centre.
5. Receipts must be dated within the promotional period to be valid.
6. Staff and retailers of Botany Town Centre and their families are eligible to vote for participating schools, but they must not submit a receipt from their place of work.
7. Receipts are invalid if illegible, forged, mutilated, copied or tampered with in any way.
8. Soliciting for receipts from customers within the centre and surrounding areas is prohibited.
9. All 'School Rewards' customers who enter the draw to win the \$1,000 shopping spree will be entered into the customer prize draw and added to the Botany Town Centre VIP database.

CUSTOMER COMPETITION DRAW DETAILS

SCHOOL COMPETITION DRAW AND PRIZE DETAILS

24. There will be three (3) prizes to be won by the participating schools.
25. The schools will be judged by the most tokens collected during the promotional period, per the quantity of pupils registered at the school. The prizes to be awarded are:
 - First Prize: \$5,000
 - Second Prize: \$3,000
 - Third Prize: \$1,000
26. Total schools prize pool valued: \$9,000
27. The winning schools will be announced on Monday 19th August, 2019.
28. The Promoter assumes no responsibility for additional costs borne by the winners including but not limited to: merchant service fees or credit card surcharges.
29. Prizes will be awarded to the winning schools in the form of a direct debit within 30 business days of receipt of a valid Tax Invoice made out by the winning school to AMP Capital Shopping Centres Ltd.
