

Chelsea Winter Cookbooks



TERMS & CONDITIONS

Spend \$300 or more on the SAME DAY and present your receipt(s) to our Customer Services Desk (between H&M and Farmers) to receive a Chelsea Winter Cookbook, while stocks last!

You can accumulate your spend across stores but it must be spent on the SAME DAY to qualify for a cookbook. Only one cookbook per receipt over \$300 spend. Only one cookbook per person, per day. Receipts must be validated on the day of spend to qualify.

- The promotion is called 'Chelsea Winter Cookbook Gift with Purchase' promotion. Participation in this campaign is deemed acceptance of the Terms and Conditions set out below.
- The Promotion commences at 9am on Wednesday 2 December 2020 and runs until 6pm on Wednesday 23 December ("Promotional Period") or until the cookbook stock has been exhausted. There is a limited number of cookbooks available for this promotion, which will be given out on a first in, first served basis. Once the total number of cookbooks is exhausted, the promotion will cease immediately. If not, the promotion will end at 6pm on Wednesday 23 December 2020.
- To be eligible for a cookbook a shopper must spend at least \$300 at any retailer at Botany Town Centre on the same day during the promotional period ("Qualifying Spend"). You can accumulate your spend across stores, but it must be spent on the same day. Receipts need to be validated on the day of purchase to receive your cookbook. Bill payments, Lay-by payments and Gift Vouchers/Card purchases from any retailer are excluded and will not be accepted as part of a Qualifying Spend.
- There is a maximum of one cookbook per individual receipt over \$300. Eg: If a receipt is valued at \$600 the offer is limited to one cookbook.
- Only one cookbook per person, per day.
- Shoppers must show their original purchase receipt(s), as proof of purchase in order to receive a cookbook. Receipts are validated by the Customer Service team (between H&M and Farmers) during Shopping Centre Hours (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Saturday 9am-6pm, Thursday & Friday 9am-9pm and Sunday 10am-6pm). No duplicate receipts will be accepted. Purchase receipts must clearly specify the store(s) of purchase, the amount of purchase and that the purchases were made on the same day as redemption.
- There are 3 different Chelsea Winter Cookbook titles to be given away over the promotional period as follows:
 - Wednesday 2 December - Wednesday 9 December: **'Everyday Delicious'**
 - Thursday 10 December - Wednesday 16 December: **'Homemade Happiness'**
 - Thursday 17 December - Wednesday 23 December: **'Scrumptious'**
- Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, Botany Town Centre, tenants and their employees of the promoter and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to participate in the promotion. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
- Incomplete, indecipherable, or illegible receipts will be deemed invalid.
- The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of purchases and reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these Terms and Conditions, tampered with the promotion process or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise fair and proper conduct of the promotion. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.
- The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
